Adding a Briefs Encountered shortcut to your Windows 10 Desktop or Taskbar

Here is a simple procedure to add a shortcut icon for Briefs Encountered to your Windows 10 desktop or taskbar.

- After installing and "unlocking" the *Briefs Encountered* program with your unique key code, locate the "Briefs Encountered" folder icon on the Start Menu program list (see (1) in Figure 1) and press the mouse left button (<u>left click</u>). Two submenu program items will appear: "Briefs Encountered" and "Unregister Briefs."
- Move your mouse cursor over the "Briefs Encountered" program icon until that entry is highlighted, then press the mouse right button (<u>right click</u>). A list of three options will appear (see (2) in Figure 1). Select "More," (3) in Figure 1, using a <u>left click</u>.





- 3. A further list of three options will appear. Using the mouse <u>left button</u>, select "Pin to taskbar" or "Open file location" depending on how you use your computer:
 - If you select "Pin to taskbar," **(4a)** in Figure 1, the "Briefs Encountered" program icon will be added to the taskbar at the bottom of the desktop view. You can then run *Briefs Encountered* at any time by a single <u>left click</u> on the taskbar icon.
 - If you select "Open file location," **(4b)** in Figure 1, the desktop view will appear with an open window listing the program's shortcut list. <u>Right click</u> on the "Briefs Encountered" entry and select "Send to" from the dropdown menu (similar to Figure 2). Then select "Desktop (create shortcut)" to complete the procedure. You can then run *Briefs Encountered* at any time by a double <u>left click</u> on the desktop icon.
